Your accountability partner is committed to:

- Helping you and holding you accountable to your personal fundraising strategy developed at the School
- Encouraging you to succeed in your finances at the launch of your ministry
- Praying with you and for you
- Being honest with you
- Confidentiality
- Being with you if you hit a snag or lose hope

What your accountability partner needs from you:

- Weekly communication initiated by you (set aside the same time each week to talk to your Accountability Partner)
- Weekly reports
- Total honesty and transparency
- A commitment that you will execute your plan

Your accountability partner is not:

- Responsible for your fundraising
- Your supervisor, but knows your supervisor’s phone number
- Your mom
